A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2021

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2021 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 181-2020 on December 15, 2020; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2021 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 2-2021 on January 19, 2021; and

Whereas at a Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting of Council held February 9, 2021 Council recommended an additional allocation of \$6,350 to be funded through the parkade reserves to perform an emergency repair on the upper barrier connection for the concrete barrier panel and a fence repair to the lower storage area of the parkade; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Council hereby authorizes an additional allocation of \$6,350 to be funded through the parkade reserves to perform an emergency repair on the upper barrier connection for the concrete barrier panel and a fence repair to the lower storage area of the parkade.
- 2. That the 2021 Municipal Capital and Operating Budgets be and are hereby amended for this purpose.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
