By-law Number 94 - 2021

A By-Law to Authorize the Execution of an Agreement Between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Kontzamanis Graumann Smith Macmillan Consulting Services for the Study for Keewatin and Norman Marine Watermain Looping and Redundancy

Whereas City administration has accepted a proposal to study, analyze and report on concepts to service the neighbourhoods of Keewatin and Norman with a second marine watermain and associated infrastructure improvements to provide looping and redundancy; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary and expedient to execute an agreement between Kontzamanis Graumann Smith Macmillan Consulting Services and the Corporation of the City of Kenora with respect to the Study for Keewatin and Norman Marine Watermain Looping and Redundancy; and

Now Therefore the Council of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. That authorization is hereby given for the City of Kenora to enter into an agreement with Kontzamanis Graumann Smith Macmillan Consulting Services and the Corporation of the City of Kenora with respect to the Study for Keewatin and Norman Marine Watermain Looping and Redundancy.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Kenora are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City of Kenora in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein and to affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
