By-Law Number 108 - 2021

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2021

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2021 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 181-2020 on December 15, 2020; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2021 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 2-2021 on January 19, 2021; and

Whereas at a Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting of Council held August 10, 2021 Council recommended a budget amendment in the amount of \$66,500 (plus HST) of which \$19,843.38 is to be funded through the Bearwise Funding Reserve and \$46,656.62 to be funded from the Solid Waste Reserve, for a municipal subsidized purchase of 250 FoodCycler Units, in order to implement a FoodCycler Pilot Program in partnership with Food Cycle Science Corporation; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Council hereby authorizes a budget amendment in the amount of \$66,500 (plus HST) of which \$19,843.38 is to be funded through the Bearwise Funding Reserve and \$46,656.62 to be funded from the Solid Waste Reserve, for a municipal subsidized purchase of 250 FoodCycler Units, in order to implement a FoodCycler Pilot Program in partnership with Food Cycle Science Corporation.
2. That the 2021 Municipal Capital and Operating Budgets be and are hereby amended for this purpose.
3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
