By-law Number 152 - 2021

A By-law to Authorize the Execution of a Contract Between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Kenora Handi Transit Board

Whereas the Corporation of the City of Kenora deems it necessary to execute a Contract between The Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Kenora Handi Transit Board with respect to the provision of the delivery of specialized transit services within the City of Kenora; and

Whereas Kenora Handi Transit is a not-for-profit charitable corporation incorporated under the Corporations Act which was created for the purpose of providing specialized transportation services to persons with disabilities in need of transportation; and

Whereas the City and the Kenora Handi Transit Board have agreed to the terms and conditions under which the Board will provide specialized transportation services within the City of Kenora; and

Whereas the City is authorized under the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 and the Municipal Act, 2001 and, in particular, paragraph 69(2)(b) of the Municipal Act, 2001, to enter into a specialized transportation service operating agreement with the Kenora Handi Transit Board;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. That the term of this Agreement commences on January 1, 2022 and ends on December 31, 2026, unless terminated earlier by either party in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Kenora are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement with the Kenora Handi Transit Board in accordance with the terms of reference, and proposal attached hereto, and affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
