By-Law Number 5 - 2022

A By-Law to authorize the Execution of a Funding Agreement Between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Federation of Canadian Municipalities for a Municipal Asset Management Program

Whereas the Government of Canada and FCM have established the Municipal Asset Management Program and the Government of Canada has funded the Municipal Asset Management Program, which is being administered by FCM; and

Whereas FCM has agreed to provide the City with a grant for the development of an asset management plan and implement CityWide Maintenance Manager software; and

Whereas at a Regular Council meeting held January 18, 2022, Council authorized a Funding Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Federation of Canadian Municipalities for a Municipal Asset Management Program; and

Whereas Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora deems it necessary and expedient to execute a Funding Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Federation of Canadian Municipalities for a Municipal Asset Management Program;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

1. That authorization is hereby given for the City of Kenora to enter into the execution of a funding agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Federation of Canadian Municipalities for a Municipal Asset Management Program.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement on behalf of the City of Kenora in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein and to affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
