By-Law Number 44 - 2022

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2022

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2022 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 150-2021 on December 21, 2021; and

Whereas at a Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting of Council held April 5, 2022 Council recommended to supplement the funding required for the Municipal Paving Capital Construction Projects by way of reallocating the following: ICIP funds in the amount of an additional \$788,176 and NORDS funds in the amount of an additional \$164,039 for Railway Street Phase II, Federal Gas tax funds in the amount of an additional \$137,000 and Future Land Development Reserve in the amount of an additional \$52,000 for Highway 17 East

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Council hereby authorizes to supplement the funding required for the Municipal Paving Capital Construction Projects by way of reallocating the following: ICIP funds in the amount of an additional \$788,176 and NORDS funds in the amount of an additional \$164,039 for Railway Street Phase II, Federal Gas tax funds in the amount of an additional \$137,000 and Future Land Development Reserve in the amount of an additional \$52,000 for Highway 17 East.
- 2. That the 2022 Municipal Capital Budget be and are hereby amended for this purpose.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
