## **By-Law Number 130 – 2022**

A By-Law to Authorize the Execution of a Funding Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation for Upgrades and Repairs to the Keewatin Memorial Arena

Whereas at a Regular Meeting of Council held September 20, 2022, Council authorized a funding agreement with NOHFC for docking upgrades and repairs to the Keewatin Memorial Arena; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora deems it necessary and expedient to execute an agreement between the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation and The Corporation of the City of Kenora to provide funding for this project;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

- 1. That authorization is hereby given for the City of Kenora to enter into an agreement with the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation for upgrades to the Keewatin Memorial arena.
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement on behalf of the City of Kenora in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein and to affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
- 3. That this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
