By-Law Number 55 - 2024

A By-Law to authorize the Execution of a Funding Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and His Majesty the King in Right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Transport (“Canada”) for the Province of Ontario for the Rail Safety Improvement Program

Whereas at a Regular meeting of Council held April 16, 2024 authorization was given to enter into an agreement with His Majesty the King in Right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Transport (“Canada”) for the Province of Ontario for the Rail Safety Improvement Program for the 16th Avenue North grade crossing improvements; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora deems it necessary and expedient to execute this agreement between the Corporation and His Majesty the King in Right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Transport (“Canada”) for the Province of Ontario for the Rail Safety Improvement Program for the 16th Avenue North grade crossing improvements;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

1. That authorization is hereby given for the City of Kenora to enter into an agreement with His Majesty the King in Right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Transport (“Canada”) for the Province of Ontario for the Rail Safety Improvement Program for the 16th Avenue North grade crossing improvements.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Kenora be and are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement on behalf of the City of Kenora in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein and to affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
