By-law Number 6 - 2026

A By-Law to Authorize the Execution of an Agreement Between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Principles Integrity for Integrity Commissioner Services

Whereas the Municipal Act, 2001 authorizes the City to appoint an Integrity Commissioner who reports to Council and who is responsible for performing in an independent manner the functions assigned by legislation and by Council pursuant to that legislation;

Whereas the City is desirous of appointing Principles Integrity as its integrity commissioner to perform the duties and responsibilities of the office pursuant to the terms of the legislation and this agreement; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary and expedient to execute an agreement between Principles Integrity and the Corporation of the City of Kenora with respect to services related to the duties of an integrity commissioner; and

Whereas at a Council meeting held on January 13, 2026 authorization was given to enter into an agreement with Principles Integrity for this purpose;

Now Therefore the Council of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. That authorization is hereby given for the City of Kenora to enter into an agreement with Principles Integrity for the supply of integrity commissioner services.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Kenora are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City of Kenora in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein and to affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
