Whereas at a Regular meeting of Council held January 13, 2026 authorization was given to enter into an agreement with His Majesty the King in Right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Employment and Social Development styled as Minister of Jobs and Families for a Coney Island Playground Project number: 019020668; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora deems it necessary and expedient to execute this agreement between the City and His Majesty the King in Right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Employment and Social Development styled as Minister of Jobs and Families;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

1. That authorization is hereby given for the Corporation of the City of Kenora to enter into an agreement with His Majesty the King in Right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Employment and Social Development styled as Minister of Jobs and Families for a Coney Island Playground Project.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Kenora be and is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein and to affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
