By-Law Number 45 - 2026

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Utility Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2026

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2026 Five Year Water and Wastewater Utility Capital Plan budget by passing By-law Number 169-2025 on December 16, 2025 and

Whereas at a Regular Council meeting held March 30, 2026 Council supported a budget amendment for the sewer and water reconstruction project of Mellick Avenue from 9th Street North to 10th Street North and the Back-Lane between 3rd Avenue South and 4th Avenue South, from 5th Street South to 7th Street South, in the amount of \$600,000.00 to be funded by debt financing; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 160-2022;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Council hereby authorizes a budget amendment for the sewer and water reconstruction project of Mellick Avenue from 9th Street North to 10th Street North and the Back-Lane between 3rd Avenue South and 4th Avenue South, from 5th Street South to 7th Street South, in the amount of \$600,000.00 to be funded by debt financing.
2. That the 2026 Five Year Capital Plan Budget be and are hereby amended for this purpose.
3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
