By-Law Number 83 - 2026

**A By-Law to Authorize the Amendment of an Agreement Between
The Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Kenora & His
Majesty the King In Right of Ontario as Represented by the
Attorney General**

Whereas The Corporation of the City of Kenora and His Majesty the King In Right of Ontario as Represented by the Attorney General reached an agreement for the Parts III and IX of Provincial Offences Act (Ontario) Interim Transfer Agreement by bylaw number 118-2024 on September 17, 2024; and

Whereas it has been deemed necessary to amend the agreement to reflect the term “Two (2) years from the Effective date” in the definition of “Expiry Date” in section 1.1 (f) of the agreement shall be replaced with the date “October 15, 2028”;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

- 1. That** the Council of the City of Kenora hereby agrees to enter into an amending agreement for the purpose of amending the agreement to reflect the term “Two (2) years from the Effective date” in the definition of “Expiry Date” in section 1.1 (f) of the agreement shall be replaced with the date “October 15, 2028”.
- 2. That** the Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Kenora be and are hereby authorized to execute the amending agreement which is effective May 19, 2026 and attached hereto and forms part of this bylaw.
- 3. That** this by-law shall come into force and be in effect following third and final reading thereof.
