By-Law Number 91 - 2026

A By-Law to Execute an Agreement Between the Kenora Central Ambulance Communications Centre Lake of the Woods District Hospital and the Corporation of the City of Kenora for the Provision of a Fire Dispatch/Control System

Whereas Council has entered into a service agreement with Kenora Central Ambulance Communications Centre Lake of the Woods District Hospital for the provision of a Fire Dispatch/Control System; and

Whereas that agreement authorized by By-law Number 182-2019 expired December 31, 2025; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary and expedient to enter into a further service agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Kenora Central Ambulance Communications Centre Lake of the Woods District Hospital for provision of a Fire Dispatch/Control System; and

Whereas at a Committee of the Whole meeting held on June 16, 2026 it was recommended to enter into a service agreement for an additional five (5) year period ending December 31, 2030;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:-

1. That authorization be hereby given to enter into a service agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Kenora Central Ambulance Communications Centre Lake of the Woods District Hospital.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk be hereby authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the Corporation of the City of Kenora in accordance with the terms and conditions as outlined in the agreement attached hereto and forming part of this By-law and to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
3. That this By-Law shall come into force and be in effect on January 1, 2026.
