By-Law Number 97 - 2026

A By-law to Appoint Building Officials Under the Building Code Act for the City of Kenora

Whereas pursuant to Sections 3(2) of the *Building Code Act*, S.O. 1992 c23, as amended, the Council shall appoint a Chief Building Official and such inspectors as are necessary for the enforcement of this Act; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary to appoint Chief Building Official, Deputy Chief Building Officials and Inspectors for the purpose of carrying out or enforcing regulations in accordance with the Building Code Act within the City of Kenora;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:

1. Appointment of Chief Building Official

Gerald Moore is hereby appointed as Chief Building Official (CBO) for the City of Kenora under the *Building Code Act*, 1992. This appointment shall take effect on June 23, 2026, and shall continue until rescinded or a successor is appointed.

2. Appointment of Deputy Chief Building Officials

Stephanie Vezina, Doug Godin and Devon Staley are hereby appointed as Deputy Chief Building Officials (DCBOs) for the City of Kenora with authority to carry out and enforce the provisions of the Building Code Act. In the absence of the Chief Building Official, a Deputy Chief Building Official may exercise all administrative functions of the Chief Building Official necessary to ensure continuity of building services.

3. Appointment of Inspectors

Pursuant to the *Building Code Act*, 1992, Barbara Mocny, Megan Opersko, Margaret Lawson, Jennifer Nicholls, Michael McKean, Grant Schwartzentruber, and Andy Lamers be and are hereby appointed as Inspectors under the *Building Code Act*, 1992, for the City of Kenora for the purpose of carrying out or enforcing regulations in accordance with the *Building Code Act*, 1992.

4. Effective Date

These appointments shall come into force and take effect on June 23, 2026, and shall remain in effect until such appointments are rescinded or successors are appointed.

5. Repeal of prior by-laws

The following by-laws are hereby repealed:

- By-law No. 008-2025, being a by-law to appoint a Chief Building Official for the City of Kenora, is hereby repealed.
- By-law No. 036-2023, being a by-law to appoint Deputy Chief Building Officials for the City of Kenora, is hereby repealed.

- By-law No. 085-2022, being a by-law to appoint Deputy Chief Building Officials for the City of Kenora, is hereby repealed.

6. Conflict

In the event of conflict between this by-law and any prior by-law, resolution or appointment instrument respecting the same appointments, this by-law shall prevail to the extent of the conflict.
