## BY-LAW NUMBER 81-2000

## A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF COMPOSITE BALLOTS AT MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

**WHEREAS** Sections 41(1) and (2) of The Municipal Elections Act provides for the use of composite ballots at municipal elections; and

**WHEREAS** prior to October 1 in an election year, Council must adopt the appropriate by-law for the use of composite by-laws; and

**WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient to use composite by-laws for municipal elections, now and in the future;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Council of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:-

- **1.** THAT the use of composite ballots be and the same are hereby approved for use in all municipal elections;
- **2.** THAT all ballots will be in the prescribed form;
- **3.** THAT the ballot form shall be amended for any election so as to provide the required information as to the date of the election, the offices to be voted upon, the listing of candidates seeking office, any number of by-laws or questions on which a vote is to be taken, and amended where necessary when the vote by mail system is in effect;
- **4.** THAT no composite ballot shall contain the names of candidates for an office, or contain a question or by-law for which the elector is not entitled to vote;
- **5.** THAT this by-law shall take effect and come into force upon third and final reading thereof;
- **6.** THAT By-law Number 65-94 of the former Town of Kenora, and any bylaws pertaining to this matter of the former Towns of Keewatin and Jaffray Melick, are hereby repealed.
