### **BY-LAW NUMBER 110-2000**

## A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE TEMPORARY CLOSING OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL STREETS FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING A WATERMAIN TO THE TRANSFER STATION SITE

**WHEREAS** Section 297(9), of The Municipal Act, provides that a By-law may be passed for closing streets to vehicular traffic, on a temporary basis, for such period as shall be specified in the By-law, and Highway or portion of a Highway under the jurisdiction of the Council, for such social, recreational, community or athletic purposes, or combination of such purposes, as may be specified in the By-law.

**AND WHEREAS** such By-law may prohibit the use, except for pedestrian traffic, of the Highway or portion of the Highway so closed during the period of closure except under the authority of a permit issued under the By-law upon such terms and conditions, including such fee for the permit as may be set out in the By-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:-

- 1. That the use, except for pedestrian traffic, of those Highways at those times more particularly described and shown in Schedule "A" attached hereto, is hereby prohibited for **the installation of a watermain to the Transfer Station Site as follows:~** 
  - from 8:00 a.m. Wednesday August 2, 2000to 6:00 p.m Friday August 4, 2000.
- **2.** Notwithstanding the foregoing:
- (i) where a permit has been issued by the Corporation of the City of Kenora, Ontario, persons involved in the construction of the said Corporation of the City of Kenora, Ontario; and
- (ii) police, fire, ambulance and public utility vehicles during an emergency, or where required to protect persons or property, may use the said portions of the Highway so closed during the period of closures.
- **3.** Such permit may be issued upon application to the Issuer of Licences and such permit may take the form of a letter signed by the Issuer of Licences.
- **4.** No fee shall be payable for such permit, but the contractor must advertise said closure publicly.
- Any person violating any of the provisions of this By-law shall be subject to penalty of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), exclusive of costs, and all such penalties shall be recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.
- **6.** That this By-law shall take effect and come into force upon the third and final reading thereof.
