

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA
BY - LAW NUMBER 124-2000**

**A BY - LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF A
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE MINISTRY
OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AND THE CORPORATION OF THE
CITY OF KENORA IN RELATION TO THE TRANSFER OF THE
PROVINCIAL OFFENCES ACT RESPONSIBILITIES.**

WHEREAS Bill 108, Streamlining of Administration of Provincial Offences Act provides authority for a municipality to enter into an agreement with the Attorney General with respect to the transfer of the Provincial Offences responsibilities for courts administration, court support functions and prosecution of matters under Part I and II of the Provincial Offences Act;

AND WHEREAS the City of Kenora under an Intermunicipal Service Agreement with the Municipal Area Partners has agreed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Attorney General to be the Municipal Partner to assume justice responsibilities under the Provincial Offences Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Kenora are hereby authorized to execute the Memorandum of Understanding attached to and forming part of this By-Law between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Her Majesty The Queen in Right of Ontario as represented as the Attorney General in accordance with the terms and conditions therein and affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
2. **THAT** this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
