**A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA TO
AMEND BY-LAW NO. 73-2000 BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE
PARTICIPATION IN THE ONTARIO MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES
RETIREMENT SYSTEM IN RESPECT OF EMPLOYEES**

WHEREAS pursuant to section 15 (1) of the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System (OMERS) Act, R.S.O. 190, Chapter 0.29 and Regulation 890 as amended, a municipality may by by-law participate in OMERS on behalf of its employees and pay to the OMERS Pension Fund the total of the employer and member contributions, and has all the powers necessary and incidental thereto:

NOW THEREFORE, the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

1. **THAT** Section 6 of By-Law Number 73-2000 be amended as follows:

“The Employer hereby certifies that employees who are engaged as Police Officers, including cadets, Police Management, Firefighters and Fire Management are entitled to retire at age 60.”

2. **THAT** this By-Law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
