## **BY-LAW NO. 156/2000**

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT OF PURCHASE AND SALE BASED UPON AN OPTION AGREEMENT DATED THE 28<sup>TH</sup> OF JANUARY, 2000 AND TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE AND TRANSFER OF LAND FROM MARGARET HANNELORE STRECKER TO THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA

**WHEREAS** The Corporation of the City of Kenora on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January, 2000 entered into an Option Agreement with Margaret Hannelore Strecker (hereby annexed as Exhibit 1) with respect to the lands and premises described as follows:

That portion of the following lands which constitute the travelled portion of the Jones Road on the Vendor's lands measured 33 feet to either side of the centre line of the said travelled portion of the Jones Road totalling 66 feet in perpendicular width on either of the following parcels:

Remainder of Parcel 14482, part of Lot 16, Concession VI, Township of Jaffray, now City of Kenora, District of Kenora, being all of the parcel.

Parcel 4333, the south half of Lot 16, Concession VI, Township of Jaffray, now City of Kenora, District of Kenora, being all of the parcel.

**AND WHEREAS** The Corporation of the City of Kenora has determined to exercise the Option in accordance with Alternative II set out in the Option Agreement on the terms and conditions set out therein in order to add the purchased lands to the municipal road system.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

- 1. **THAT** The Corporation of the City of Kenora shall exercise the option identified as Alternative II in the Option Agreement made as of the 28<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2000;
- 2. **THAT** the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute the Notice Exercising Option and any and all documents required to complete the transaction;
- 3. **THAT** this By-Law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
