

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA

BY-LAW NUMBER 19-2001

A BY-LAW TO ASSUME, STOP UP, CLOSE AND SELL THAT PART OF THE ROAD ALLOWANCE LYING IN FRONT OF THE EAST PART OF LOCATION D-666, TOWNSHIP OF MELICK, NOW THE CITY OF KENORA, IN THE DISTRICT OF KENORA, DESIGNATED AS PART 1 ON PLAN 23R-10464.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora, deems it necessary and expedient to assume, stop up, close and sell that part of the road allowance lying in front of the east part of Location D-666, Township of Melick, now in the City of Kenora, in the District of Kenora, being designated as Part 1 on Plan 23R-10464.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Kenora has identified Part 1 on Plan 23R-10464 as surplus land and has reached an Agreement with Lloyd Henton to sell the said lands;

NOW THEREFORE The Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. THAT part of the Road Allowance, described as follows:

Part of the Road Allowance lying in front of the East Part of Location D-666, Township of Melick, in the City of Kenora, in the District of Kenora, and being designated as **PART 1 on PLAN 23R-10464**

be and the same is hereby assumed, stopped up and closed.

2. THAT the Corporation of the City of Kenora shall Transfer to Lloyd Henton part of the road allowance lying in front of the East Part of Location D-666, Township of Melick, now City of Kenora, District of Kenora, designated as Part 1 on Plan 23R-10464, in exchange for that part of the travelled road designated as Part 3 on Plan 23R-3943.

3. THAT the Purchasers undertake and agree to pay all costs pertaining to a survey (as required) and costs of advertising, preparation and registration of the Transfer/Deed of Land and all the related legal and transfer documentation.

4. THAT the Mayor and the Clerk be and they are hereby empowered to execute documents in connection with the assuming, stopping up, closing and selling of the hereinbefore mentioned lands.


5. THAT this By-Law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.


6. THAT By-Law No. 859 of the former Town of Jaffray Melick be hereby repealed.
