

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA

BY-LAW NUMBER 42-2001

A BY-LAW TO ASSUME, STOP UP, CLOSE THAT PART OF THE ROAD ALLOWANCE IN FRONT OF MINING LOCATION A-16, NOW BLOCK C, PLAN M.33, TOWN OF KENORA, NOW CITY OF KENORA, IN THE DISTRICT OF KENORA, DESIGNATED AS PARTS 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 AND 6 ON PLAN 23R-10480

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora, deems it necessary and expedient to assume, stop up, close that part of the road allowance in front of Mining Location a-16, now Block C, Plan M.33, Town of Kenora, now the City of Kenora, in the District of Kenora, being designated as Parts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 on Plan 23R-10480.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Kenora has identified Parts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 on Plan 23R-10480 as surplus land.


NOW THEREFORE The Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** part of the road allowance, described as follows:

Part of the road allowance in front of Mining Location A-16, now Block C. Plan M.33, Town of Kenora, now the City of Kenora, in the District of Kenora, and being designated as **PARTS 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, on PLAN 23R-10480**
be and the same is hereby assumed, stopped up and closed.
2. **THAT** the Mayor and the Clerk be and they are hereby empowered to execute documents in connection with the assuming, stopping up, and closing of the hereinbefore mentioned lands.
3. **THAT** this By-Law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
