

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA

BY-LAW NUMBER 55-2001

A BY-LAW TO SELL THAT PART OF THE ROAD ALLOWANCE IN FRONT OF MINING LOCATION 432-P, NOW LOT 16, PLAN M.668, TOWNSHIP OF JAFFRAY, NOW CITY OF KENORA, IN THE DISTRICT OF KENORA, DESIGNATED AS PART 2 ON PLAN 23R-10230 TO DALE ALEXANDER CEDERWALL

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WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora, deems it necessary and expedient to sell part of the road allowance in front of Mining Location 432-P, now Lot16, Plan M.668, in the Township of Jaffray, now the City of Kenora, in the District of Kenora, being designated as Part 2 on Plan 23R-10230.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Kenora has identified Part 2 on Plan 23R-10230 as surplus land and reached an Agreement with Dale Alexander Cederwall to sell the said lands;

NOW THEREFORE The Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. THAT part of the road allowance, described as follows:

Part of the road allowance in front of Mining Location 432-P now lots 16 and 17, Plan M.668, Township of Jaffray, now the City of Kenora, in the District of Kenora, and being designated as PART 2 on PLAN 23R-10230.

be and the same is hereby declared as surplus land and has been assumed, stopped up and closed by By-Law 7-2001.

2. THAT the Corporation of the City of Kenora shall sell to Dale Alexander Cederwall part of the road allowance as shown on Plan M.668, designated as Part 2 on Plan 23R-10230, Township of Jaffray, now City of Kenora, in the District of Kenora, for the sum of ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS plus 7% GST, for a total consideration of \$1,070.00.

3. THAT the Purchasers undertake and agree to pay all costs pertaining to a survey (as required) and costs of advertising, preparation and registration of the Transfer/Deed of Land and all the related legal and transfer documentation.

4. THAT the Mayor and the Clerk be and they are hereby empowered to execute documents in connection with the assuming, stopping up, closing and selling of the hereinbefore mentioned lands.

5. THAT this By-Law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
