**BY-LAW NUMBER 56-2001**

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 9-97 BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE TRAFFIC ON THE ROADS AND HIGHWAYS OF KENORA**

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Kenora adopted By-law Number 9-97 on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1997; and

**WHEREAS** all by-laws of the former Town of Kenora remain in effect until 2004 or until they are repealed, in accordance with the Minister of Municipal Affairs' Order; and

**WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient to amend By-law Number 9-97;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:-

1. A New Schedule "R" to By-Law No. 9-97 be added pursuant to Section 182 (2) and Regulation 615 (31 32) of the Highway Traffic Act as follows:-

**DO NOT ENTER**

Where appropriate sign(s) are erected and are on display, "**DO NOT ENTER**" regulation shall take effect.

**LOCATION**

At the laneway running parallel to east side of King George School property, situated between River Street and Seventh Avenue South at a point where the lane turns south at the River Street Intersection.

2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the third and final reading thereof.
