## **BY-LAW NUMBER 122-2001**

## A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE TEMPORARY CLOSING OF THE ROAD COMMONLY KNOWN AS FIRE BASE ROAD BETWEEN AIRPORT ROAD AND JONES ROAD

**WHEREAS** Section 297, Subsection 1 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O., 1990, Chapter M.45 permits the temporary closing of any highway or portion of a highway for any period during the construction, repairing, or improvement of such highway or portion thereof, or of any work under, over, along, across, or upon such highway or portion thereof; and

**WHEREAS** the City of Kenora requires the temporary closure of the road commonly known as Fire Base Road between Airport Road and Jones Road;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

- 1. THAT except for pedestrian and local traffic, "Fire Base Road" between Airport Road and Jones Road be temporarily closed commencing **Tuesday**, **September 25**, **2001 at 6:00 a.m. until Wednesday**, **October 31**, **2001 at 6:00 p.m.**, for the purpose of constructing the earth, rock and granular base porton of "Fire Base Road" in connection with the sewer and water project;
- 2. THAT this closure be subject to the following conditions being met by the City and ultimately, the contractor:
  - i) provision of signs; lights; and/or barricades as required in accordance with Section 297(1) of the Municipal Act;
  - ii) adequate advertising of the proposed closure for the information of the public;
  - iii) direct notification to all Emergency Services;
  - iv) provision and proof of \$5 million liability insurance prior to the closure
- 3. THAT the following may use the said portions of the highway so closed during the times mentioned above: police, fire, ambulance and public utility vehicles during an emergency, or where required to protect persons or property.
- 4. THAT this By-law shall take effect and come into force upon the third and final reading thereof.
