BY-LAW NUMBER 3-2003

A BY-LAW TO ASSUME FIRST STREET, 2nd STREET AND 3rd STREET, SITUATE ON DUFRESNE ISLAND, AS SHOWN ON REGISTERED PLAN M.134 and PART OF THE ROAD ALLOWANCE IN FRONT OF MINING LOCATION 298E, NOW IN FRONT OF LOT 1 AND PART OF FIRST STREET, DESIGNATED AS PARTS 2, 3, 4 AND 5 AS SHOWN ON PLAN 23R-10724, IN THE CITY OF KENORA, IN THE DISTRICT OF KENORA

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora, deems it necessary and expedient to assume FIRST STREET, 2nd STREET AND 3rd STREET as shown on Registered Plan M.134 and part of the Road Allowance in front of Mining Location 298E, now in front of Lot 1 and part of First Street, designated as Parts 2, 3, 4 and 5 as shown on Registered Plan 23R-10724, situate on Dufresne Island, formerly Town of Keewatin, now the City of Kenora, in the District of Kenora.

NOW THEREFORE The Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT FIRST STREET, 2nd Street and 3rd Street, situate on Dufresne described as follows:

PART OF PARCEL 3949, being First Street, 2nd Street and 3rd Street situate on Dufresne Island, as shown on registered Plan M.134, formerly Town of Keewatin, now the City of Kenora, in the District of Kenora


be and the same is hereby assumed.
- 2. THAT that part of the Road Allowance in front of Mining Location 298E, now in front of Lot 1 and part of First Street, designated as Parts 2, 3, 4 and 5 as shown on Registered Plan 23R-10724, formerly Town of Keewatin, now City of Kenora, in the District of Kenora

be and the same is hereby assumed.
- 3. THAT the Mayor and the Clerk be and they are hereby empowered to execute documents in connection with the assumption of the herein before mentioned lands.
- 4. THAT this By-Law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
