## BY-LAW NUMBER 12-2004

BY-LAW TO ASSUME THOSE PARTS OF THE STREETS AND TWO LANES, IN THE TOWN OF KENORA, NOW CITY OF KENORA, IN THE DISTRICT OF KENORA, AS SHOWN ON REGISTERED PLAN M.63 DESIGNATED AS PARTS 7, 8, 9, 10 AND 11 ON PLAN 23R-10931

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora, deems it necessary and expedient to assume those parts of the Streets, namely part of Twelfth Avenue South (formerly Beck Avenue, By-Law No. 460, GR 785), part of Sixth Street South (formerly Gertie Street, By-Law No.460, GR 785), Part of Kyle Street and two lanes as shown on Plan M.63, all being part of Parcel 2771, and further designated as 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 on Plan 23R-10931, Town of Kenora, now City of Kenora, in the District of Kenora.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** those parts of the Streets, namely part of Twelfth Avenue South (formerly Beck Avenue, By-Law No. 460, GR 785), part of Sixth Street South (formerly Gertie Street, By-Law No.460, GR 785), Part of Kyle Street and two lanes as shown on Plan M.63, all being part of Parcel 2771, and further designated as 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 on Plan 23R-10931, Town of Kenora, now City of Kenora, in the District of Kenora, be and the same are hereby assumed.
- 2. **THAT** the Mayor and the Clerk be and they are hereby empowered to execute documents in connection with the assumption of the herein before mentioned lands.
- 3. **THAT** this By-Law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
