A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA
TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF LAND
FROM THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA
TO KENORA ANISHINAABE-KWEG ABORIGINAL WOMEN'S ORGANIZATION

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Kenora, is the owner in fee simple, of the property described as Part 1, in the Town of Kenora, now City of Kenora, as shown on registered Plan 23R-9498, being Parcel 41031 in the Register for the District of Kenora; and

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Kenora has accepted a tender from Anishinaabe-Kweg Aboriginal Women's Organization for the sale of the above described property;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

1. **THAT** the Corporation of the City of Kenora declare the above property surplus.
2. **THAT** The Corporation of the City of Kenora shall accept the Tender of Anishinaabe-Kweg Aboriginal Women's Organization and to sell to Anishinaabe-Kweg Aboriginal Women's Organization, the land described as Part 1 on Plan 23R-9498, in the Town of Kenora, now City of Kenora, District of Kenora, being Parcel 41031 in the Register for the District of Kenora, for the sum of \$245,000.00 plus \$17,150.00 for G.S.T.
3. **THAT** the sale of the lands herein described is hereby authorized.
4. **THAT** the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement of Purchase and Sale on behalf of the municipality.
5. **THAT** this By-Law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
