BY-LAW NUMBER 99 – 2004

**A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF LAND TO
THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA**

WHEREAS Subsection 31 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O., 2001, provides that a Council of a local municipality may, by by-law, establish a highway; and

WHEREAS after January 1, 2003, land may only become a highway by virtue of a by-law passed under subsection (1); and

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Kenora requires that a portion of the Carlton Road, more particularly described as Part of Parcel 31440, now Parcel 43453, being part of broken lot 15, Concession 2 of Melick, now in the City of Kenora, District of Kenora, as surveyed out to and transferred to the City of Kenora;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Kenora has reached an Agreement with Ross Melville Johnson to transfer the above described property for Municipal purposes and more particularly for a portion of a road, namely Carlton Road.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. THAT lands affected by the By-law were acquired by the City for the purposes of a highway.
2. THAT the Corporation of the City of Kenora acquired lands from Ross Melville Johnson, described as a part of parcel 31440, part of Broken Lot 15 in the Second Concession of the Township of Melick, designated as Part 1 on Plan 23R-7221, now recorded as parcel 43453, now in the City of Kenora, District of Kenora, to be assumed as a highway for public/municipal purposes;
3. THAT the portion of the road is hereby named Carlton Road;
4. THAT the purchase price of the said road shall not exceed the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00);
5. THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents required to complete this transaction.
6. THAT this By-law shall take effect and come into force from and after the final passing thereof.
