A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 127-2001 BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE TRAFFIC ON THE ROADS AND HIGHWAYS OF THE CITY OF KENORA

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Kenora adopted By-law Number 127-2001 on the 9th day of October, 2001; and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the By-law to accommodate changing requirements;

NOW THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:-

1. Schedules B,C, O, and P are hereby amended by changing the following:-

SCHEDULE "B" NO PARKING – TOW AWAY ZONE:

SCHEDULE "O" STOP SIGNS AT INTERSECTIONS:

AMEND: Sylvan Street and Wolsley Street	North bound on Sylvan Street
TO READ: Sylvan Street and Wolsley Street	North bound on Sylvan Street East Bound on Wolsley Street
ADD: Fourteenth Street North and Mellick Avenue	East bound on Fourteenth Street North
ADD: Fourteenth Street North and Veterans' Drive	West bound on Fourteenth Street North

SCHEDULE "P" YIELD INTERSECTIONS:
