## BY-LAW NUMBER 30-2005

## A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE EXEMPTIONS TO NOISE BY-LAW NUMBER 40-2001 AND DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS BY-LAW NUMBER 41-2001 FOR NATIONAL DEFENCE 116 INDEPENDENT FIELD BATTERY ACTIVITIES IN THE CITY OF KENORA

**WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Kenora adopted Noise By-law Number 40-2001 on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of April, 2001 and Discharge of Firearms By-Law Number 41-2001 on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of April 2001; and

**WHEREAS** it is deemed necessary to authorize an exemption to Noise By-Law Number 40-2001 and Discharge of Firearms By-Law Number 41-2001 to allow National Defence 166 Independent Field Battery to conduct a pyrotechnics demonstration within the City of Kenora during its Open House on March 26, 2005 at the Kenora Armoury;

**NOW THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Council of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:-

- 1. An exemption be authorized under Noise By-Law Number 40-2001 to allow a pyrotechnics demonstration.
- 2. An exemption be authorized under Discharge of Firearms By-Law Number 41-2001 to allow firing of 105 mm Howitzer blank rounds of artillery.
- 3. That National Defence be required to publicly advertise these exemptions in a local newspaper at least 10 days in advance of the date of the demonstration.
- That this By-Law shall be in effect for the one day of March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2005 only for the events scheduled at the Department of National Defence Property at the Kenora Armoury.
