BY-LAW NUMBER 6 - 2006

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE INSTALLATION AND USE OF EXTENSION CORDS OVER OR UPON PUBLIC WALKWAYS.

WHEREAS Section 128(1) of The Municipal Act, 2001, authorizes a local municipality to prohibit and regulate public nuisances, including matters that, in the opinion of Council, are or could become or cause specific nuisances; and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to adopt a by-law for this purpose as the placing of electric extension cords over or upon public sidewalks in the City of Kenora is deemed to be a both a public nuisance as well as a public health and safety matter;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

- 1. THAT no-one shall use or allow electric extensions cords to be placed over or upon public sidewalks, except as provided for in this by-law.
- 2. THAT the owner or occupier of any premises in the City of Kenora who does not have a driveway, may place electrical extension cords over a public sidewalk provided that they abide by the attached standards as described in Schedule "A" to this by-law for the use of extension cords over or upon public sidewalks.
- 3. THAT any person who contravenes any portion of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is subject to the provisions of The Provincial Offences Act.
- 4. THAT this By-law shall take effect and come into force upon third and final reading thereof.
