BY-LAW NUMBER 59 – 2006

**A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF LAND TO
THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA**

WHEREAS Subsection 31 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O., 2001, provides that a Council of a local municipality may, by by-law, establish a highway; and

WHEREAS after January 1, 2003, land may only become a highway by virtue of a by-law passed under subsection (1); and

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Kenora requires that the a portion of the Anderson Road and the Davis Road, more particularly described as Part 1 on Plan 23R-11198, now the City, District of Kenora, as surveyed out to and transferred to the City of Kenora;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Kenora has reached an Agreement with Ross Melville Johnson to transfer the above described property for Municipal purposes and more particularly for a portion of a road, namely Anderson Road and Davis Road.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. THAT lands affected by the By-law were acquired by the City for the purposes of a highway.
2. THAT the Corporation of the City of Kenora will acquire, from Joan Elizabeth Belanger, a part of property described as Concession 8 of Jaffray, North Part of Lot 3 RESIDUE being Parcel 18030, now in the City of Kenora, District of Kenora, and designated as Part 1 on Plan 23R-11198, to be assumed as a highway for public/municipal purposes;
3. THAT the portion of the road is hereby named Anderson Road, where appropriate or Davis Road as appropriate;
4. THAT the purchase price of the said road shall not exceed the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00);
5. THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents required to complete this transaction.
6. THAT this By-law shall take effect and come into force from and after the final passing thereof.
