BY-LAW NUMBER 105- 2006

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital and Reserves to be incorporated into the sums required for municipal purposes, during the year 2006

WHEREAS on April 24, 2006, Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2006 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2006 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 49-2006; and

WHEREAS on May 23, 2006, Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2006 Water & Sewer Utility Budget by passing By-law Number 75-2006; and

WHEREAS at a Standing Committee Meeting of Council held August 15, 2006, Council approved the purchase of 4 inch high volume water supply line for Norman / Keewatin in the amount of \$9,225, plus applicable taxes, shipping and handling, as well as the purchase of related adapters, not included in the aforementioned price, to be funded as follows:

- 50% to be funded through the Fire Service Grant Deferred Revenue Account; and
- the remaining 50% of the net cost related to this combined purchase be funded from the Water & Sewer Reserve; and

WHEREAS public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 14-2003;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. THAT the 2006 Capital Budget and Water & Sewer Utility Budget be amended to add an additional expenditure to be funded from the Fire Service Grant Deferred Revenue Account and Water & Sewer Reserve respectively.
2. THAT the 2006 Capital Budget and Water & Sewer Budget be amended to reflect a withdrawal from the Fire Service Grant Deferred Revenue Account and an additional appropriation from the Water & Sewer Reserve respectively for this purpose.
3. THAT this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
