BY-LAW NUMBER 111 – 2006

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE NAMING OF A PRIVATE ROAD

WHEREAS Subsection 38 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O., 2001, provides that a Council of a local municipality may, name or change the name of a private road after giving public notice of its intention to pass the by-law; and

WHEREAS notice has been given according to the Municipal Notice By-law; and

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Kenora entered into a subdivision agreement with 1629700 Ontario Inc. on November 1, 2005; and

WHEREAS in order to prepare a final plan of subdivision, the roads on said plan must be named;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. THAT lands described as “Road A” on the draft plan of subdivision is hereby named Darlington Trail;
2. THAT in accordance with the subdivision agreement, the City shall erect a street sign, indicating the road name, at the Owner’s expense;
3. THAT the road is hereby named Darlington Trail;
4. THAT this By-law shall take effect and come into force from and after the final passing thereof.
