BY-LAW NUMBER 147-2006

**A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF LAND TO
THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA**

WHEREAS Subsection 31 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O., 2001, provides that a Council of a local municipality may, by by-law, establish a highway; and

WHEREAS after January 1, 2003, land may only become a highway by virtue of a by-law passed under subsection (1); and

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Kenora requires that a portion of the Duffus Road, more particularly described as Part of Parcel 8212, Farm Location D476 being on the North side of Darlington Bay of the Winnipeg River, District of Kenora, designated as Part 10 on Plan 23R-11291 as surveyed out to be transferred to the City of Kenora as a condition of a Development Agreement;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Kenora has reached an Agreement with Kathleen Campbell, to transfer the above described property for Municipal purposes and more particularly for part of the Duffus Road.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. THAT lands affected by the By-law were acquired by the City for the purposes of a highway;
2. THAT the Corporation of the City of Kenora acquired from Kathleen Campbell, Part of Parcel 8212, Part 10, Plan 23R-11291, being part of Duffus Road, Town of Keewatin, now in the City of Kenora, District of Kenora, as a highway for public/municipal purposes;
3. THAT the road portion is hereby named Duffus Road;
4. THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents required to complete this transaction;
5. THAT this By-law shall take effect and come into force from and after the final passing thereof.
