

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 29 – 2008**

**A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF LAND TO  
THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA**

**WHEREAS** Subsection 31 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O., 2001, provides that a Council of a local municipality may, by by-law, establish a highway; and

**WHEREAS** after January 1, 2003, land may only become a highway by virtue of a by-law passed under subsection (1); and

**AND WHEREAS** the Corporation of the City of Kenora requires that a portion of the Essex Road, more particularly described as Part 1 of Plan 23R-11416, now the City, District of Kenora, as surveyed out to be transferred to the City of Kenora

**AND WHEREAS** the Corporation of the City of Kenora has reached an Agreement with George Ivor Hulmes to transfer the above described property for Municipal purposes and more particularly for a portion of a road, namely Essex Road.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. THAT lands affected by the By-law were acquired by the City for the purposes of a highway
2. THAT the Corporation of the City of Kenora acquired from George Ivor Hulmes, part of the remainder of parcel 7968 Part of Lot 13, Concession 8 of the Township of Jaffray, Described as Part1 of Plan 23R-11416, now in the City of Kenora, District of Kenora, as a highway for public/municipal purposes;
3. THAT the road is hereby named Essex Road,;
4. THAT the purchase price of the said road shall not exceed the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00);
5. THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents required to complete this transaction.
6. THAT this By-law shall take effect and come into force from and after the final passing thereof.
