

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 162 – 2008**

**A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF LAND TO  
THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA**

**WHEREAS** Subsection 31 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O., 2001, provides that a Council of a local municipality may, by by-law, establish a highway; and

**WHEREAS** after January 1, 2003, land may only become a highway by virtue of a by-law passed under subsection (1); and

**WHEREAS** the Corporation of the City of Kenora requires that the a portion of the Essex Road, more particularly described as part of property described as 1020 C Anderson Road, CON 1M N PT LOT 17;RP KR48 PART 1 PCL 25464 and 1020 A Anderson Road CON 1M PT LOT 17;RP KR48 PART 3 PCL 31155 and 1020 B Anderson Road CON 1M PT LOT 17;RP KR48 PART 2 PCL 22918, designated as Parts 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 of Plan 23R-11541, now the City, District of Kenora, as surveyed out to and transferred to the City of Kenora;

**AND WHEREAS** the Corporation of the City of Kenora has reached an Agreement with Robert Kortz, et al, to transfer the above described property for Municipal purposes and more particularly for a portion of a road, namely Anderson Road.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. THAT lands affected by the By-law were acquired by the City for the purposes of a highway.
2. THAT the Corporation of the City of Kenora assumes as a highway for public/municipal purposes lands acquired from Robert Kortz, et al particularly, part of property described as 1020 C Anderson Road, CON 1M N PT LOT 17;RP KR48 PART 1 PCL 25464 and 1020 A Anderson Road CON 1M PT LOT 17;RP KR48 PART 3 PCL 31155 and 1020 B Anderson Road CON 1M PT LOT 17;RP KR48 PART 2 PCL 22918, designated as Parts 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 of Plan 23R-11541;
3. THAT the portion of the road is hereby named Anderson Road;
4. THAT the purchase price of the said road shall not exceed the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00);
5. THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents required to complete this transaction.
6. THAT this By-law shall take effect and come into force from and after the final passing thereof.
