**BY-LAW NUMBER 22 - 2009**

**A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF LAND TO  
THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA**

**WHEREAS** Subsection 11(2) of The Municipal Act, R.S.O., 2001, provides that a Council of a local municipality may pass by-laws, subject to the rules set out in subsection (4), respecting public assets of the municipality acquired for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act ; and

**WHEREAS** the Corporation of the City of Kenora required that a portion of the lands owned by Abitibi Consolidated Inc., described as Part 1 of Plan 23R-11479, now the City, District of Kenora, as surveyed out to be transferred to the City of Kenora, for municipal purposes; and

**WHEREAS** the Corporation of the City of Kenora has reached an Agreement Abitibi Consolidated Inc. to transfer the above described property for Municipal purposes and more particularly for a portion of a waste transfer station;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. THAT lands affected by the By-law were acquired by the City for municipal purposes;
2. THAT the Corporation of the City of Kenora acquired from Abitibi Consolidated Inc., Concession 4 of the Township of Jaffray, Described as Part1 of Plan 23R-11479, now in the City of Kenora, District of Kenora, for public/municipal purposes;
3. THAT the purchase price of the said road did not exceed the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00);
4. THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents required to complete this transaction.
5. THAT this By-law shall take effect and come into force from and after the final passing thereof.
