

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 90 - 2009**

**A BY-LAW TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS ON THE KENORA  
POLICE SERVICES BOARD FROM FIVE TO THREE MEMBERS.**

---

**WHEREAS** the Kenora Police Services Board has been comprised of five (5) Members for a number of years; and

**WHEREAS** it is Council's desire that the Kenora Police Services Board be comprised of three (3) Members rather than five (5) in anticipation of the transition of city-wide policing by the Ontario Provincial Police in July, 2009; and

**WHEREAS** in accordance with the Police Services Act the Board of a municipality whose population does not exceed 25,000 shall consist of three (3) Members;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Council of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:-

1. THAT the Kenora Police Services Board be reduced from a five member Board to a three member Board.
2. THAT in accordance with the Police Services Act, the Board be comprised of the head of the Council (or if the head chooses not to be a Member of the Board, another member of Council); one person who is neither a member of Council nor an employee of the municipality; and one person appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
3. THAT this By-law shall take effect and come into force on July 20, 2009.
