BY-LAW NUMBER 8 - 2010

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 32-2009 AN AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KENORA AND LARRY
CRUIKSHANK, FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ANICINABE
PARK**

WHEREAS on March 9, 2009 Council adopted By-Law number 32-2009, adopting the by-law to execute an agreement with Larry Cruikshank for the Operation and Maintenance of Anicinabe Park; and

WHEREAS the Council now deems it necessary to adopt amendments to this by-law pertaining to the agreement;

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to amend by-law number 32-2009 by by-law to meet changing requirements with respect to Section 1. c. and;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:-

1. THAT Section 1. C. be replaced with the following:

1c. Cruikshank shall not allow the parking of seasonal R.V. rentals and shall adhere to the Ontario Parks rules and Standards, with the exception of the length of stay. The length of stay is not to exceed 28 (twenty-eight) days within a 31 (thirty-one) day period. Cruikshank shall not allow long-term storage or semi-permanent or permanent structures on the camp sites or storage areas. Cruikshank shall not allow parking in the public parking lot or docking at the public docks between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

2. THAT this By-law shall take effect upon final passing thereof.
