

The Corporation of the City of Kenora

By-law Number 92 - 2010

A By-law to repeal the Terms of Reference for various Boards and Committees established by Council.

Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kenora agreed at a Committee Meeting held May 10, 2010 that various Boards and Committees are no longer required for purposes of advisory bodies to Council; and

Whereas two of the Boards/Committees so identified had previously approved Terms of Reference for the administration of the Committee; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary and expedient to repeal the Terms of Reference for those Committees being removed as a municipal board or committee due to either their inactivity; duplication; or lack of continued need;

Now Therefore The Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. **That** the following Boards and Committees be abolished as previously established by Council:-
 - Aboriginal Urban Affairs Committee
 - Community Committee on Homelessness
 - CUPE Negotiating Committee
 - Fire Fighters' Negotiating Committee
 - Emergency Planning Committee
 - Kenora Children's Coalition
 - Kenora Health Care Providers Group
 - Kenora Port Authority
 - Kenora Public Advisory Group for Weyerhaeuser
 - Native Street Patrol Advisory Committee
 - Seniors Coalition Committee
 - Sign Committee
2. **That** the following applicable by-laws which established the Terms of Reference for two of the above-noted Committees be hereby repealed:
 - #5-2008 (Aboriginal Urban Affairs Committee)
 - #33-2008 (Kenora Port Authority)
3. **That** this by-Law shall take and come into force on November 30, 2010.
