By-Law Number 101- 2010

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be Incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes During the Year 2010

Whereas on February 8, 2010 Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2010 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2010 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 18-2010; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary and expedient to transfer \$66,200.00 plus net impact of applicable taxes for the Winnipeg River West Branch Bridge from the Roads Reserve; and,

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby Enacts as follows:

- That Council hereby authorizes the transfer of \$66,200.00 plus net impact of applicable taxes for the Winnipeg River West Branch Bridge from the Roads Reserve; and,
- 2. **That** in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007, public notice is hereby given that Council intends to amend its 2010 Solid Waste Capital Budget and its Municipal Five Year Capital Plan at its April 19, 2010 meeting; and
- 3. **That** the proposal submitted by Stantec, Winnipeg, Manitoba, for Pre-Design and Detail Design for the Keewatin Channel Bridge in the amount of \$43,800 (plus applicable taxes) and for the Winnipeg River West Branch Bridge –Rehabilitation Option in the amount of \$66,200 (plus applicable taxes) be accepted.
- 4. **That** the 2010 Municipal Operating Budget and Five Year Capital Plan be amended for this purpose.

That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
