A By-Law to Deem all applicable Municipal By-laws with a Three-Year Term of Council Reference to mean 'the Term of Council.'

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted various by-laws reflecting certain matters and appointments to be in accordance with 'a three year term of Council'; and

Whereas in 2006 the Municipal Act was amended changing the term of a municipal Council to four years;

Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Council of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:-

- That effective immediately, reference to a 'three year term of Council' cited in any municipal by-laws currently in effect with respect to 'Committee Terms of References' and/or 'appointments', etc. be hereby deemed as being in accordance with 'the term of Council' unless otherwise so stated.
- That as specific by-laws come up for review which contains the three year term reference, that such by-laws be amended to reflect 'the Term of Council' as deemed necessary.
