## By-Law Number 162- 2010

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be Incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes During the Year 2010

**Whereas** on February 8, 2010 Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2010 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2010 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 18-2010; and

**Whereas** on July 12, 2010 Council of the City of Kenora deemed it necessary to amend the 2010 Capital Budget to authorize the increase for the total estimated cost of the Fit and Finish of the New Fire and Emergency Services Facility in the amount of \$138,000 plus net impact of applicable taxes; and

**Whereas** it is deemed necessary and expedient to amend the 2010 Municipal Capital Budget and to further authorize the increase for the total estimated cost of the Fit and Finish of the new Fire and Emergency Services Facility in an additional amount of \$50,000.00 plus net applicable taxes; and

**Now Therefore** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby Enacts as follows:

- 1. **That** Council hereby authorizes the amendment to the 2010 Municipal Capital Budget to authorize an appropriation of \$50,000.00 plus net of applicable taxes from the Fire Station Reserve; and,
- 2. **That** in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007, public notice is hereby given that Council intends to amend its 2010 Operating and its Municipal Five Year Capital Plan at its September 8th, 2010 meeting; and
- 3. **That** the 2010 Municipal Operating Budget and Five Year Capital Plan be amended for this purpose.

The Corporation of the City of Kenora:

**That** this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
