A By-Law To Authorize a Variance to By-Law Number 150-2010 A By-Law to Regulate The Keeping of Animals Within the City of Kenora

Whereas Council adopted By-Law Number 150-2010 on August 9, 2010, approving a Comprehensive By-Law to regulate the Keeping of Animals within the City of Kenora;

And Whereas deems it necessary and expedient to consider variances to the By-Law to meet certain unique circumstances or conditions from time to time as they arise; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary and expedient to authorize a variance to the by-law under Section 3.1, no dwelling or property within the Municipality shall house more than two (2) dogs; and

Now Therefore the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. **That** a variance be granted under Section 3.1 of By-Law Number 150-2010, to permit the keeping of four (4) dogs for a variance of two (2) dogs to Catherine Berglund of 810 River Drive, Kenora;
2. **That** this variance is granted to Catherine Berglund for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of this by-law taking effect;
3. **That** all four (4) dogs are to be properly licensed for 2011 year when the dog tags become available.
4. **That** this By-law shall take effect and come into force upon third and final reading thereof.
