By-law Number 11 - 2011

A By-Law to Amend Comprehensive Traffic By-law Number 127-2001, as amended, to Regulate Veteran Plate Parking.

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted By-law Number 127-2001 on October 9, 2001 to regulate traffic on the roads and highways of the City of Kenora; and

Whereas Council is desirous of amending the by-law to provide for regulations concerning “Veteran Plate Parking”;

Now Therefore Be It Resolved That the Council of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:-

- 1) THAT By-law Number 127-2001, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following:
 - Definitions – Section 2:
“**Veteran’s License Plate**” – means a provincial license plate issued to a vehicle owned by, and registered to a Canadian Veteran, and in which, at the time of parking, the Veteran was an occupant therein;
 - Section 5 - Veteran Plate Parking:
“**Special Regulation**” – a vehicle displaying a Canadian Veteran’s license plate in accordance with the definition contained in this by-law shall be exempt from the provisions of ‘metered parking fees’ as set out in the applicable Schedules to By-law Number 127-2001, as amended.
- 2) That despite the inclusion of these new sections, all other provisions of By-law Number 127-2001, as amended shall continue to apply.
- 3) That in accordance with Section 5.5 to By-law #127-2001, as amended, “no person shall allow a vehicle to remain parked in a Parking Meter Zone for a period of time exceeding the maximum meter time shown on the meter.
- 4) That this by-law shall take effect and come into force upon third and final reading thereof.
