A By-law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be Incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes During the Year 2010

Whereas on February 8, 2010 Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2010 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2010 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 18-2010; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary and expedient to transfer funds from the Compressor Capital Budget to Animal Control in order to purchase a drop deck boat; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary and expedient to transfer funds from the Gear Washer/Dryer Project to Emergency Services in order to purchase kitchen and laundry appliances for the new facility; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:

- That a transfer of funds be authorized from the Public Works Facility in the amount of \$3,000.00 be authorized in order to purchase a drop deck boat for Animal Control;
- 2. That a transfer of funds be authorized from the Gear Washer/Dryer project line to cover kitchen and laundry appliances at the new Emergency Services Facility.
- 3. That the 2010 Municipal Operating Budget and Five Year Capital Plan be amended for these purposes.
- 4. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
