## The Corporation of the City of Kenora By-law Number 15 - 2011

## A By-law to Amend Notice By-law Number 144-2007 with respect to the giving of Notice for the Sale of Land

Whereas Council adopted By-law Number 144-2007 on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2007, being a by-law to provide for the giving of Notice; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary and expedient to make changes to the Notice By-law particularly as it relates to the sale of municipal land;

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:

1. Schedule "A" to By-law Number 144-2007 is hereby amended by deleting the current section referencing "Sale of Land" and replacing it with the following:-

268 (repealed) Sale of Land	Notice Not Required Under the Municipal Act	Municipal Policy:
Sale of Land	Under the Municipal Act	(1) Prior to the sale of any municipal lands, vacant or otherwise, excepting road/shore allowances:  Before passing a by-law, Council shall give public notice of its intention to pass the by-law by placing adequate notice on the Council agenda preceding the meeting where the by-law shall be adopted.
		(2) Prior to the sale of any municipal road/shore allowances:  Before passing a by-law, the Clerk shall have published in a local newspaper once a week for two (2) successive weeks, a notice as prepared by the City Solicitor explaining Council's intention to sell same, following which Council shall give public notice of its intention to pass the by-law by placing the notice on the Council agenda preceding the meeting where the by-law shall be adopted.

2. This by-law shall take effect and come into force upon third and final reading thereof.
