## A By-law to amend By-law Number 127-2001 being a By-law to Regulate Traffic on the Roads and Highways of the City of Kenora

Whereas the Council of the City of Kenora adopted By-law Number 127-2001 on the 9th day of October, 2001; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary to amend the By-law to accommodate changing requirements;

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:-

**1.** That **Schedule "B"** – "No Parking Areas-Tow Away Zone" be and is hereby amended by adding the following:

AMEND: Bernier Drive	From Roundabout, southerly	West	Anytime

for 121 metres

TO READ: Bernier Drive From Roundabout, southerly West Anytime for 132 metres

**2.** That **Schedule "D"** – "45° Angle Parking Areas" be and is hereby amended by deleting the following:

STREET	LOCATION	SIDE

DELETE: Bernier Drive From 13 metres north of West 1<sup>st</sup> Street South,

northerly for 43 metres

3. That **Schedule "G"** – "Parking Meter Zones" be and is hereby amended by adding the following:

STREET	PART OF STREET	SIDE

DELETE: Bernier Drive From 13 metres north of West

1<sup>st</sup> street south northerly

for 43 metres

ADD: Bernier Drive From 132 metres south of West

Roundabout southerly for

35 metres

**4**. That **Schedule "K"** – "Disabled Parking on Streets and Highways" be and is hereby amended by adding the following:

DELETE: Bernier Drive	From 196 metres north of 2 <sup>nd</sup> Street South, northerly for 7.8 metres	West	45°	2
ADD: Bernier Drive	From 175 metres north of 2 <sup>nd</sup> Street South, northerly for 5 metres	East	45°	1

**5. That** this By-law shall take effect and come into force upon third and final reading.
