

# The Corporation of the City of Kenora

## By-law Number 23 - 2012

**A By-law to Repeal By-law Number 165-2005, being a By-law to execute a Memorandum of Understanding between the Corporation of the City of Kenora, the Kenora Police Service and Ontario Provincial Police (Kenora Detachment), and the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services on behalf of the Office of the Fire Marshall.**

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**Whereas** Council adopted By-law Number 165-2005 on the 12th day of December, 2005, with respect to execution of a Memorandum of Understanding between the Corporation of the City of Kenora, the Kenora Police Service and Ontario Provincial Police (Kenora Detachment), and the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services on behalf of the Office of the Fire Marshall; and

**Whereas** upon recommendation of the Emergency Services Manager, it was agreed at a Committee of the Whole meeting held March 12, 2012 that the MOU is no longer relevant to the needs and circumstances of the City of Kenora and its Fire and Emergency Services Division;

**Now therefore be it resolved that** the Council of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:

1. **That** By-law 165-2005 be and is hereby repealed.
2. **That** this by-law shall take effect and come into force upon third and final reading thereof.
